Donate Day – It was agreed that we would hold a 'Donate Day', possibly in Slaithwaite Community Centre, where people can bring along up to 3 good quality items they would like to donate to the fashion show. Some will be used in the actual show and some will be sold on the rails after the show to make money for the 3 charities. Some of the sorted clothes could be stored at Tiff's if it is needed.

Rough Costs – *Printing – 500 postcards, 30 posters, tickets (possibly 150 tickets), costs needed *Hall Hire – Tunnel End (£50 - £70), Prices needed for Civic and Mechanics *Stock – up to £100 if needed *Dressing the stage and decorations - £50? *Refreshments - £20?
